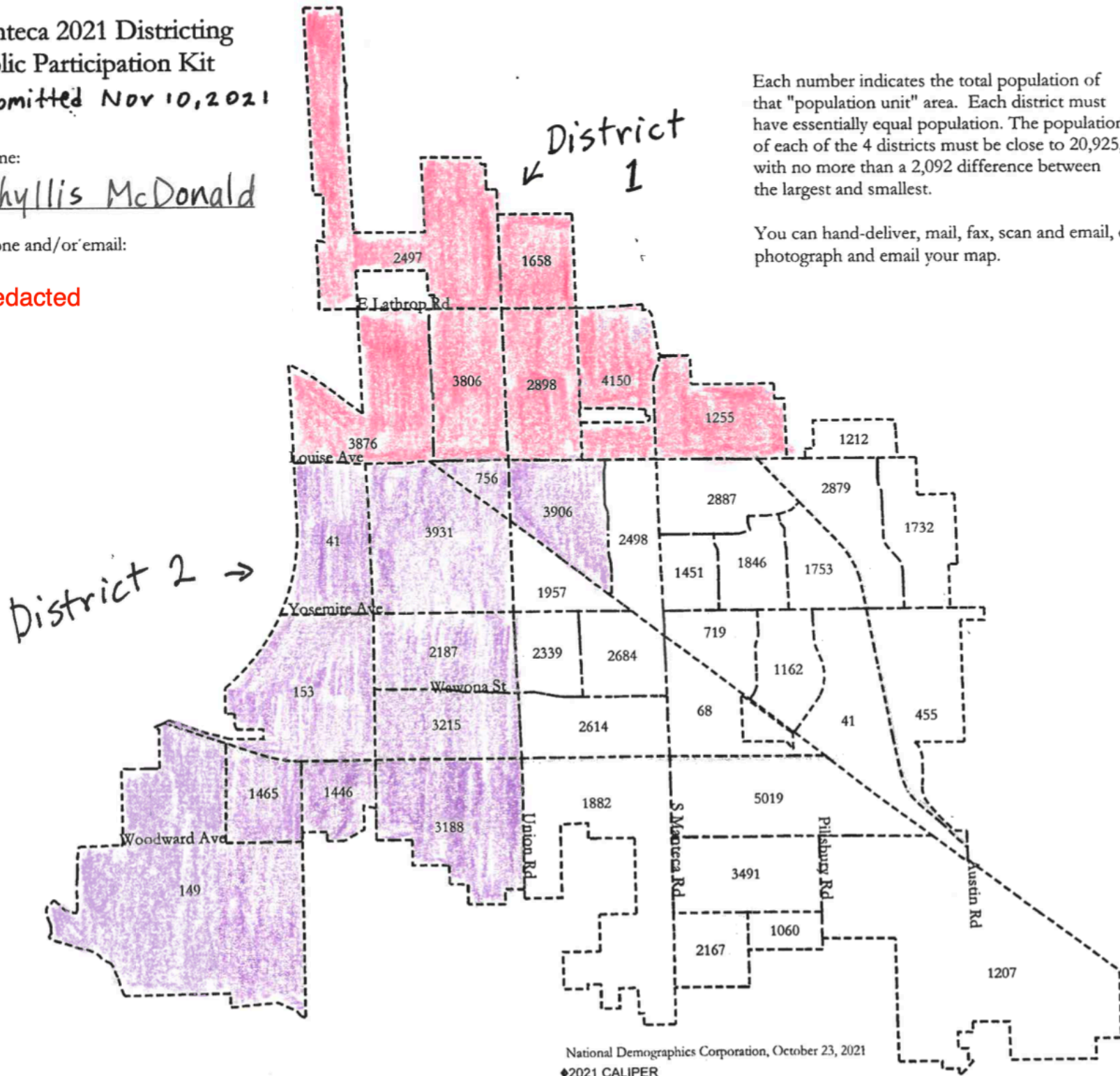

Districts 1 and District 2 comments

1. District map #1 – residents 20,140

* This district includes two large senior communities which have common interests.

* This district has a common interest in Airport Way and in Lathrop Road regarding STAA trucks using those streets and their effect on air quality, noise, road quality and safety of auto drivers and pedestrians.

* This district has a common interest in future development north of Lathrop Road along Union Road and along Airport Way, including CenterPoint's current and future development.

2. District map #2 - 20,437

* District 1 and 2 have a common interest in what happens on Airport Way and Louise Avenue regarding STAA trucks traversing these streets and causing safety issues for auto drivers and quality of life issues for residents living along those routes.

* District 1 and 2 have a common interest in the future development on the west side of Airport Way.

* Airport Way down past highway 120 is of common interest to district 2. Airport Way continues south of highway 120 and could extend into a proposed Raymus Parkway.
